



GUIDELINES FOR VISITING THE LIBRARY

The Library is open for limited use only.



LIBRARY HOURS:

Inside access hours are as follows:

- Monday, Tuesday & Thursday 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Wednesday 10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

10-11 a.m. Mon. - Thurs. is reserved for high risk and senior patrons.

- Saturday 10:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. for ALL patrons

Curbside Pickup hours are as follows:

- Monday, Tuesday & Thursday 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
- Wednesday 9:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.



LIBRARY VISITS:

- For the safety of all visitors, the number permitted in the library at one time is limited. Entrance is on a first come, first served basis.
- Visits are for 60 minute sessions, with a limit of one session per day.
- Each session may be used to browse the library stacks, use a computer, or scan/photocopy/fax documents.

SAFETY:

- Masks **MUST** be worn the entire time you are in the building.
- Frequent hand washing or sanitizing is required. Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the library.
- Public restrooms are located in the lobby of Town Hall.
- The Children's Room is open to adults only. A small children's browsing collection is available in the main library for children to look at.
- Most seating has been removed. No meeting rooms or study areas are available.
- No cash transactions - copying is limited to exact change. Faxing and printing are temporarily free.
- High touch surfaces will be sanitized between sessions.



THINGS TO NOTE:

- A confidential list of all visitors will be maintained to support contact tracing.
- Please follow all signage and physical distancing guidelines.
- Please **DO NOT** enter the Library if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Check our website and social media for the latest updates and changes to in person library services.
- All returned or ILL materials are quarantined for 1 week before being processed.
